**Oils & Palette Knife  
Painting**

Painting with oils and palette knives the  
*alla prima* (all at once) way!

Painting in oils with palette knives is fun, enjoyable, and quickly rewarding! The wet-into-wet, all one layer technique is a spontaneous and very fast method of painting, suitable for all levels of expertise. The objective of this workshop is to escape the details! Palette knife painting allows you to paint quickly and spontaneously, using the responsive buttery thickness of the oil paint to express and capture your impression of color, light and movement. Beginners to advanced painters learn a new technique: the *alla prima* way!

Want to explore your creative imagination? Gain confidence, follow your own creative path, and produce art at a minimal cost in supplies or to cost to your ego? Try mixed media! We will learn to gather materials – almost anything is suitable – and collage/arrange them into a specific project the first day. The second day of the class is imagination unleashed – start with your idea or just a feeling, and watch the mixed media suggest and direct the formation of an artwork personal to you. There is no set procedure or rules for mixed media- literally, anything goes. If you can glue, staple, nail, stitch, tape, tie, paint, scribble or fold, you can put a personal work of art together that will be satisfying and lots of fun!

Assemblage is the process of adding bits and  
pieces of found and recycled objects together to  
create an image, a message or just a feeling.  
This workshop will take all the varied materials  
you can find or source in your garage, junk  
drawer, thrift store or even wrecking yard, and  
show you how to assemble them – glue, tie, nail,  
staple, twist and bind them – to make a low-cost  
art object with a high-price look! This is an  
opportunity to explore memories – taking your  
souvenirs and creating a sculpture “home” for  
them, or an imaginary world. There are no set  
rules, the supplies can be minimal in cost, and  
the rewards of getting to play with lots of glue are  
priceless!
